Reports to: Director of Surveys

Location: Survey Division (Seychelles)

Job Summary:

Manage the country's spatial data infrastructure, lead projects to maintain and densify survey control points, oversee mapping projects, and ensure the accuracy of cadastral layers.

Key Duties:

- Maintain and update the national survey control network database and provide access to authorized users via a digital platform.
- Lead and manage specialized geodetic projects, advising on the best geodetic reference frame.
- Oversee aerial mapping and photogrammetry projects, including drone mapping surveys.
- Investigate and resolve cadastral anomalies (boundary overlaps, double beacons).
- Conduct field checks for examination and cadastral units.

- Bachelor's Degree in Surveying and Mapping Sciences or a related field.
- A Master's Degree in the related field will be considered an added advantage.

Job Summary:

Lead and supervise survey operations, manage technical teams, advise on survey matters, and contribute to staff training.

Key Duties:

- Plan, organize, and oversee all types of surveys in line with the Land Survey Act.
- Assign work to technicians and monitor progress.
- Maintain and calibrate survey markers and instruments.
- Examine cadastral survey records and liaise with stakeholders.
- Prepare reports and maintain survey records.

Responsibilities

- To manage the allocated Section's resources under his/her supervision.
- Positively promote the organization's image at all times.
- Within the scope of one's responsibilities, appropriately enforce the Division's/Ministry's rules, policies and regulations.
